ECOTOX: In 1995, MED received funding from the U.S. Department of Defense's Strategic Environmental Research and Development Program (SERDP) and the U.S. EPA's Office of Research and Development to develop a unified interface called ECOTOX to assist in searching and retrieving data from the AQUIRE, PHYTOX and TERRETOX databases. In March of 1996, ECOTOX was released to governmental users through a telnet access procedure. In February, 2000 it was released as a web based interface system.

The ECOTOXicology database (ECOTOX) is a source for locating single chemical toxicity data for aquatic life, terrestrial plants and wildlife. ECOTOX was created and is maintained by the U.S. EPA, Office of Research and Development (ORD), and the National Health and Environmental Effects Research Laboratory's (NHEERL's) Mid-Continent Ecology Division (MED).

Resolutions and Recommendations on important conservation issues are adopted every four years by this unique global environmental parliament of governments and NGOs, guiding IUCN's policy and programme of work as well as influencing many other organizations around the world. All Members in good standing can propose motions (draft decisions) to the IUCN World Conservation Congress.

At the Members' Assembly, Members vote on IUCN's programme of work for the following four years and also elect the IUCN President and Council, and manage the business affairs of the Union.

The 2012 Members' Assembly was held during the IUCN World Conservation Congress in Jeju, Republic of Korea. For the first time, morning sessions were held during each day of the Forum starting from 8 September. This allowed to connect the Congress themes and main messages of the Forum to the IUCN Programme for 2015-2016 and results from 2009-2012.



The last three days of the Assembly were dedicated to:

- = the reports from the different IUCN commissions
- = the elections of the IUCN Council, President, and Treasurer, and
- = the adoption of additional motions.

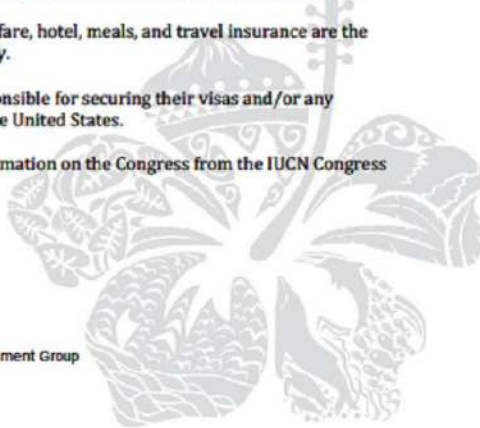
