Students who fail SSLC, II PUC exam can enrol for classes again

Govt amends rules to help them prepare better for re-exam

BENGALURU Students who fail SSLC or second-year pre-university examination can seek readmission and attend regular classes while preparing to take the exam again.

The Karnataka government has amended the rules to help students prepare better and prevent them from dropping out of higher studies.

Hitherto, students who failed SSLC or II PUC examination had to prepare on their own or attend private coaching. Rules did not permit them to attend regular classes in high school or college.

The rules have been amended now, and high schools and PU colleges informed.

Primary and Secondary Education Minister Tanveer Sait told reporters here on Thursday. The rules are applicable to both government and private institutions. If private institutions refuse them readmission, students can enrol in government colleges.

"After getting admission, students can attend classes of subjects in which they have failed. Students who want to improve their score can also get readmission and attend classes," the minister added.

Laptops for high scores
The state government will soon provide free laptops to 750 students of government high schools who scored more than 90% in the 2016 SSLC examination.

The government will also provide free uniforms, textbooks and bicycles to students at government and aided schools, Sait said.

Teacher shortage
Replying to queries, Sait said government and aided schools in Karnataka faced a shortage of 13,306 teachers. "We will calculate the number of additional vacancies that could arise due to retirement of teachers in the next two years and accordingly take up fresh recruitment," he said.

The government will continue posting teachers from districts that have excess number of them to districts that face their shortage, the minister said.

Amendments will be made to the Karnataka State Civil Services (Regulation of Transfer of Teachers) Act, 2007, to make district a unit for transfer. At present, taluk is considered a unit for transfer.

Teachers' transfer stayed
Sait appreciated the efforts of a class 8 student from Puttur, Dakshina Kannada district, for sending a text message to Home Minister G Parameshwara seeking his intervention to stop the transfer of four teachers from his school.

Dhivik Rai had sent a message to Parameshwara, saying that all students in his school opposed the transfer of four teachers.

Parameshwara intervened and made a request. Accordingly, the teachers were reported to the school, Sait said.

Sait, who took charge of Primary and Secondary Education last month, said that as per the directions of Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, circulars had been sent to all senior officers in the department to clear pending files within a week.

12 Indian fish species on verge of extinction in Bengaluru lakes

BENGALURU, DHNS: As many as 12 indigenous Indian species of fishes found in city lakes face the danger of going extinct in a few years due to increasing pollution and climate change, says an ongoing study by a team of researchers from the Bangalore University.

The study focuses on relation between the aquatic life and climate change.

Dr M Ramachandru Mohan, H.O.D, Department of Zoology, is conducting the study along with a few of his PhD students.

The team studied fish life in 10 lakes between Bengaluru and Melekoru (in Doddaballapur taluk of Bengaluru rural district). "The vulnerability of fish in Bengaluru lakes has increased manifold in the last five years," Mohan, who is studying fish and other aquatic life in Bengaluru for the past 15 years, said.

danger," said Mohan. In Karnataka, 201 freshwater fish species have been found. Of these, 40 fish species are under threat and urgent conservation measures are needed to be implemented to ensure their survival, says the study.

It goes on to say that the native freshwater fish diversity in water bodies is declining rapidly. The crucial reason for the decline are the destruction of habitat due to construction of dams and barrages, pollution and exploitative fishing practices.

Climate change is generally causing the waters to warm as well as bringing changes to rainfall patterns, water levels, river flow and water chemistry.

The predominant presence of exotic species like Tilapia, Silver carp, Grass carp and African catfishes in rivers and reservoirs is because they can tolerate high pollution and static water levels.

Mohanty's name cleared for UIDAI DDG post



BENGALURU, DHNS: state government on Thursday cleared the name of IAS officer Prasad Mohanty for the post of Deputy Director General (DDG), Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), Bengaluru.

A 1994 batch IPS of Mohanty is in the thick of controversy after he had named as one of the accused in the 2011 Gopaspatil case in Madhri.

A source in the government confirmed the process of shortlisting for the post of DDG. Mohanty's name was listed and the file was on Thursday.

Mohanty had worked for the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) for several years and after getting his state, he worked for Lokayukta, Bengaluru Commission and as Criminal Investigator.

HC orders lower court to secure Nityananda case papers from cops

BENGALURU: The High Court on Thursday directed the Ramnagar court to secure the documents related to the rape case against Nityananda in Bidadi, from the police.

Justice H Billappa directed the lower court to summon the investigating officer (IO) T V Prabhakar and secure the documents pertaining to the case.

Nityananda had approached the lower court for the documents of statements of 31 witnesses including actor Ranjitha,

medical reports of Aarthi Rao and Nityananda which were done at different hospitals, email correspondence of Aarthi Rao and a person named Bharanjoji.

The IO had turned down Nityananda's request stating that the trial in the case is yet to commence and these details could not be disclosed as charges are yet to be framed.

Later, Nityananda's disciple Gopal Sheelam Reddy approached the High Court seeking directions to the police to provide them the documents that were denied by the IO.

The bench directed the lower court to summon the IO and secure these documents. It also directed Reddy to approach the lower court.
